Water Bottles

As water bottles left in direct sunlight will speed up the process of bacterial growth, it is important that they are not left with water in for more than 24 hours and should be cleaned / disinfected before re-use. Please remember to encourage them to be brought home daily to be cleaned and disinfected, to reduce the risk of bacterial infections such as E-coli and Scarlet Fever.
