School Meals

Do you qualify for Free School Meals? Lots of people qualify without even realizing it. All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are provided with a hot meal as part of the Governments universal free school meal programme. No additional qualifications are required. Some children may be eligible from Year 3 onwards as well. Parents and children could be missing out by not taking advantage of free hot school lunches. Healthy eating is vital to children's wellbeing and eating well has been shown to help maintain concentration levels and aid learning. To find out whether your children qualify for free school meals and to apply visit plymouth.gov.uk and search free school meals.
