Latest Covid guidance

Self-isolation:

You are not required to self-isolate if you live in the same household as someone with COVID-19, or are a close contact of someone with COVID-19, and any of the following apply:

- you're fully vaccinated
- you're below the age of 18 years and 6 months
- you've taken part in or are currently part of an approved COVID-19 vaccine trail
- you're not able to get vaccinated for medical reasons

If there is a positive case of COVID-19 in your household, please book your child in for a PCR test and keep them at home until they receive a negative result. If the result is positive your child will have to self-isolate.
