

#### New Start / Finish Times

Dear Parents

As we finish our first half term, we have reviewed the arrangements in school. Thank you for being so efficient in dropping off and picking up your children from school at the allotted times. We now feel confident that we can get all the children into school safely in a shorter time period. With the undoubtedly colder and wetter weather on the way, this should benefit us all. The additional time in the afternoon will also give us some vital time to continue to support the children to catch up from the schooling missed this year.

The entry and exit points have not changed just the times. These are highlighted below.

From Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> November the new start and end times will be:

8.30 am Yrs 5-6 enter via the drive gate.

- Yrs 1-2 enter by playground gate

8.40am Nursery, Foundation enter via drive gate

-Yrs 3-4 enter via playground gate

Home Time.

3.00pm Yrs 5-6 leave via Charlotte Street gate.

- Yrs 1-2 Leave.

- Nursery leave via drive gate.

3.10pm Yrs 3-4 Leave.

3.10pm Foundation leave via drive gate.

As before, we request if you have children in number of year groups, please arrive at the time for the **last** child, 3.10pm, and we will keep their siblings with their class's adults until you arrive.
