Free School Meals

As from next week we will start the Free School Meal vouchers instead of the weekly food parcels. These will be £15 per child and will be sent weekly. The voucher codes will be emailed to you from Edenred, the instructions on how to redeem them will be within the email you receive. These vouchers will only be issued to children who are entitled and are not currently attending school. The free school meal children who are attending school are offered a hot meal as normal and therefore will not be issued a voucher. If you experience any issues please contact the school office.
